## Procedures

-  Participants will be drug tested by Wheeling Hospital (urine sample) on 4 different occasions throughout the school year. There will be a \$10 fee that will cover the cost for the entire year. This covers cost of the testing kit; no revenue is gained by Wheeling Hospital or Shadyside High School.
-  Parents will be contacted by Wheeling Hospital, or a representative of the Belmont County Schools Staying Clean program, if a positive result is indicated. Family and student privacy is assured, as no public information will be given.
-  Wheeling Hospital will confirm any positive result by shipping the sample to a lab for further examination. Medical prescriptions may be requested of parents as some medicines can mimic certain illegal drugs.
-  Negative test results will ensure a student's continuation in the Staying Clean Program. Positive results will remove a student until the next test comes around, and will require counseling provided by student services at no cost.

## Incentives and Rewards

-  Discounted athletic passes (1/2 price) at all home athletic events.
-  Academic coupons such as homework passes, bonus points, elimination of lowest grade.
-  Wristbands or T-shirts to wear indicating membership in the club.
-  Extended lunches at times throughout the school year.
-  Fun planned field trips at times throughout the school year through fundraising efforts and donations from outside groups.
-  Membership recorded on student's permanent record, transcript.
-  Other surprises as suggested by the committee!
-  Being DRUG FREE is in itself a reward. The incentive is to provide you with every opportunity to keep a clear mind and healthy body. There is nothing more important than good health, and being drug free is the first step.
