Reading: We will be mastering the letter Cc and its' sound this week. We continue to work on sequencing, characters, and setting in the stories that we read. The students should be proficient at "at" words and starting to master all other short "a" words. The students will be tested on their oral reading ("at" words) this week.

Math: We are working on teen numbers and they should be able to know a teen number represents 10 + so many left over.

Ex. 14 = 1 ten and 4 ones. We are working on writing numbers past 20, counting past 50, and recognizing the nickel and its' value.

Homework:

Tuesday - read sentences with "at" words and sight words in them

Wednesday - letter "C" in the Alphabet Book

Thursday - writing Cc/writing numbers to 20.

Miscellaneous: Today we sent home several number cards. Please cut out and play "war", we call it top -it in our maths series.

Please continue to practice flashcards and read sentences, as Report Card testing will begin this week and take place the week when we return from Christmas vacation.
