Reading: This week we will focus on the letter L and its' sound. We are also starting to master the "it" word family. We will mix "at" and "an" words with "it" words like: bit, fit, hit, kit, lit, mit, nit, pit, sit, wit, and zit. Please take the flashcard letters and practice spelling out words that have short "a" as in the past and "it" words now.

Math: We will continue more/less with numbers to 20 and subtraction facts methods. Please work on subtraction flashcards.

Homework: Monday: practice flashcards

Tuesday: Home Link 5-7 and 5-9 & practice flashcards

Wednesday: Letter L in the Alphabet Homework Book & flashcards

Thursday: Write L and toy graph & flashcards
