



KINDERGARTEN NEWS 2/20/17

Reading: This week we are on the letter Dd and starting the phonogram -ig. Encourage your child to build 3 letter words with "i" in the middle. We have sent home a word family sheet with all kinds of short a and short i words that your child should be able to sound out without your help. We are well into writing sentences now too! You can see from the projects that your child is bringing home that we encourage them to sound spell. Every letter in the word is not important, just the ones they hear...for now!

Math: We continue to skip count by 5's and 10's to 100 in class. This counting is a very important step for 1st grade. We are working on number families with addition and subtraction. We are doing number stories in class to aid in the addition or subtraction method. We continue to compare numbers to 100. Learning the number sequence to 100 is also a major step to 1st grade work.

Homework: Tues.: ending sounds/flashcards

Wed.: letter "D" Homework Picture Book/flashcards

Thurs.: write Dd/math/flashcards

Miscellaneous: Report card testing starts next week.

The students need to be able to count to 50, count to 100 by 10's, count objects to 15, recognize and write to 15, and count forward when given a number.
