Reading: We are working on mastering rhyming words, the letters in the children's names and matching capital to lower case.

Math: We are working on patterns, comparing lengths, heights, and weight, counting to 20, and counting back from 5 to 0.

Homework: We are sending home an alphabet strip with capital and lower case letters on it. This is for you to keep and practice finding letters at home. We use them as games at school. Some suggestions for home: Put a penny on the letter Tt or put a M&M on the letters in your child's name. The food can be eaten as a reward! Keep the strip at home for your use. We have our own to use with the kids at school. Homework will be on Tues. and Thurs. this week, rhyming sheets.

Miscellaneous: New flashcards are sent home every Monday. Please practice nightly until they are mastered. The very first set had a blank square which is to be matched up with the number 0. The square with one dot is to be matched up with the number 1. Please continue to work on the lunch code number at home. We realize some children may not get a school lunch, however, it is important for them to memorize this number since it is used as their password for Star Early Literacy testing.
