

KINDERGARTEN NEWS - 2/20/18

Reading: This week we are working on the letter Qq. We will also evaluate their oral reading. The majority of the kids are reading -it words well by now. Please take the flashcard letters out and make 3 letter words for your child to sound out. We are also focusing on blends at the beginning of words and ending sounds so you can make words such as: plan, map, scrap, flab, scam, flag, spit, trip, flat, and skid. Continue to practice flashcards nightly. *We will begin testing for report cards the week of February 26th. They will be evaluated on all the flashcards we have sent home from the beginning of the year. *Another evaluation: to be able to create and write sentences.

Math: We are working on subtraction stories. We will be playing games in school that will enhance their addition and subtraction skills. We will be counting on with coins in class too. We add pennies to nickels, and pennies to dimes and trade in pennies and nickels for dimes. We do not do very much with quarters in Kindergarten, we just introduce them.

Report card evaluation: count to 50, count, objects to 15, write numbers to 15, count to 100 by 10's, compare sets (more and fewer).

Homework: Tuesday: read sentences in preparation of the book that they will be tested on this week

Wednesday: letter Q in the Alphabet Homework Picture Book.

Thursday: write Qq/sentences.

Miscellaneous: 2 hour delay this week, Friday, February 23rd for Teacher Professional Development.
