Right to Read Week Activities: This Week

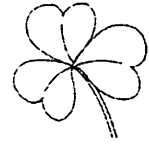
Mon. - Camouflage Day

Reading: This week we will work on the letter Zz. We continue to work on blends (2 letters at the beginning of words) like smack, brick, Stan, drip, glad. We will test their oral reading this week. We continue to work on sequencing story parts, as well as details about stories that we read in class. Don't forget about the sight words in their flashcard bags!



Math: We continue to work on equal groups to 20, more and fewer to 100, and addition and subtraction in class. We will test their measuring skills soon.
