



Kindergarten News 3/19/18

Reading: We are focusing on the short "o" vowel sound this week. Please practice sounding out 3/4 letter words that are similar to these: dot, quit, pig, pot, Kim, Don, trap, skip, snap, did, etc. Basically, your child should be able to read any short vowel three letter words with a, i or o in the middle or 4 letters if you put a blend at the beginning (flat, twig, spot, drop).

Math: We will continue to work on counting with pennies, nickels and dimes. Your child is expected to count to 100 by the end of the year, write numbers from 0 to 20, and count 20 objects. We encourage them to count and write much higher. We will also be working on understanding teen numbers and measurement. Please practice addition and subtraction flashcards.
