

Title I Program

What is Title I?

Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) provides financial assistance to States and School Districts to meet the needs of educationally at-risk students. The goal of Title I is to provide extra instructional services and activities, which support students identified as failing or most at-risk of failing. They are chosen using multiple evaluation points and teacher/parent input. All Title I Funds go to support 1 teacher at Jefferson Elementary and 1 teacher at Leona Middle School. These teachers support students who are having some type of academic difficulty.

Shadyside School District is a Targeted Assisted District. This means the students are identified through a Multi-criteria Evaluation. Students then are served from a priority list. The students with the greatest needs are served first. This gives our students who may be struggling a support system.
