***Please read the following information as it pertains to spectator protocol at all home athletic events. The information provided is directly related to guidelines handed down from the Ohio High School Athletic Association, state and local health departments, The Center for Disease Control, and the Governor's Office. It is VITAL that ALL OF US follow these guidelines in order to keep all of the people attending these events safe. Please remember that the elderly, and people who have underlying health conditions are the ones most affected by Covid-19. 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***ALL SPECTATORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE MASK AT ALL HOME ATHLETIC EVENTS. These MASKS are to remain on, covering the mouth and nose, at all times while inside the facility, or at the football field.***

***ALL spectators should check their temperatures BEFORE coming to the events as well. If your body temperature is 100 degrees or higher, DO NOT ATTEND THE EVENT. If you are not feeling well prior to going to the game, or have any symptoms of Covid-19, DO NOT ATTEND THE EVENT. Symptoms include: Fever or Chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Fatigue, Body Aches, Headache, Loss of Taste or Smell, Sore Throat, Congestion or Runny Nose, Nausea or Vomiting, Diarrhea.***

***There will be markings in the bleachers, the fences where people stand, and the concession stand that will indicate SAFE SOCIAL DISTANCING. Once fans are inside the stadium, they will be permitted to either sit or stand along bleachers.***

***All spectators WILL NOT be permitted to gather outside of the locker room, or on the gym floor following the game. All spectators will be asked to meet their child or relative on the team, outside of the facility or school.***

***Please limit trips to the concession stand by sending one person per family. Social distancing will be difficult here, but by wearing a mask it will cut down on possible transmission of the virus.***

***The Shadyside Local School District will do everything in its' power to assist you in enjoying a safe environment at our home athletic events. It is up to everyone in attendance to do their part.***

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## ATHLETIC AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR EVENT SPECTATOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

The Shadyside Local School District (“District”) Board of Education (“Board”) is pleased to permit the below-named individual (“Spectator”) with the opportunity to enter upon the Board’s property for the purpose of attending an athletic and/or extra-curricular event.

Close physical contact and interaction between spectators, students, District staff, and other parties are common features of athletic and extra-curricular events. Uniquely, the Spectator’s attendance at the athletic and/or extra-curricular activity is occurring during the COVID-19 global pandemic, wherein the risk of contracting a highly contagious and potentially lethal disease is increased by close physical contact and interaction between people. While the District will endeavor to take precautions for the safety of individuals on Board property, there can be no guarantee that these precautions will prevent the Spectator from contracting COVID-19, or any other highly contagious disease, which could result in sickness, injury or death.

Therefore, in consideration of the Board’s agreement to permit the Spectator to enter upon Board property for the purpose of attending an athletic and/or extra-curricular event, the undersigned Spectator, and/or his/her parent/guardian if under age 18, hereby release the Board, its members, employees, agents and volunteers, in both their official and individual capacities, from any and all liability or demands for personal injury, psychological injury, sickness, or death, which may be incurred by the Spectator as a result of his/her contraction of COVID-19, or any other contagious disease, as a consequence of his/her attendance at the event. The Spectator further agrees to comply with all applicable state laws, local ordinances, Executive Orders, Board Policies, Administrative Regulations, and directives of District staff members, including those pertaining to health and safety, while present upon Board property.
