## November 5, 2020

**Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship:** Application online at [www.enf.elks.org/MVS](http://www.enf.elks.org/MVS). Applicants will be judged on academics, service, leadership, and financial need.

**Deadline: November 15, 2020.**

**Ohio JCI Senate Charitable and Education Foundation:** Two categories to choose from Academic-Based (2) \$1000 scholarship or Need-Based (4) \$1000. You may only submit an application in one category. Applications are available in the Guidance Office.
